


Claimant 2

The CRS has preliminarily determined to recommend that the Commission deny an award to Claimant 2. No information submitted by Claimant 2 led to the successful enforcement of the Covered Action within the meaning of Section 21F(b)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rules 21F-3(a)(3) and 21F-4(c) because none of the information that the Claimant 2 submitted:

1. caused the Commission to (i) commence an examination, (ii) open or reopen an investigation, or (iii) inquire into different conduct as part of a current Commission examination or investigation under Rule 21F-4(c)(1) of the Exchange Act; or





² To the extent that Claimant 2 applied for a related action award in connection with the Criminal Action, because Claimant 2 does not qualify for an award in the Covered Action, Claimant 2 is not eligible for a related action award in connection with the Criminal Action. A related action award may be made only if, among other things, the claimant satisfies the eligibility criteria for an award for the applicable covered action in the first instance. *See* 15 U.S.C. § 78u-6(b); Exchange Act Rule 21F-3(b), (b)(1); Rule 21F-4(g) and (f), and Rule 21F-11(a); Order Determining Whistleblower Award Claims, Release No. 34-84506 (Oct. 30, 2018); Order Determining Whistleblower Award Claims, Release No. 34-84503 (Oct. 30, 2018).
