Jeffrey J. Diermeier, CFA, is president and CEO of CFA Institute. He had previously served CFA Institute in numerous volunteer roles, including three years on the Board of Governors, six years on the CFA Curriculum Committee, and three years on the Board of CFA Society of Chicago. Prior to joining CFA Institute, Mr. Diermeier was global chief investment officer at UBS Global Asset Management. He worked with UBS and its predecessors (primarily Brinson Partners) for almost 30 years, in various positions, including head of asset allocation, head of the U.S. equity division, co-head of global equity, and deputy chief investment officer. Mr. Diermeier has received two Graham and Dodd Scroll Awards for research articles published in the *Financial Analysts Journal* and a Roger Murray Award from the Institute for Quantitative Research in Finance. He is a member of the board of the University of Wisconsin Foundation, where he has endowed a chair in finance, and a former member of the investment committee of the University of Chicago Endowment. He is co-trustee of the Diermeier Family Foundation. Current appointments include the Q-Group Board, XBRL International XII Board of Advisors, and the NACD Not-for-Profit Advisory Council. Mr. Diermeier holds a BBA and an MBA from the University of Wisconsin at Madison.
