Scott C. Evans is Executive Vice President, Asset Management and Chief Executive Officer of TIAA-CREF's investment advisory subsidiaries Teachers Advisors, Inc. and TIAA-CREF Investment Management LLC. He is responsible for development of TIAA-CREF's investment products and oversight of the company's more than \$380 billion in assets under management.

Mr. Evans has more than 20 years of experience at TIAA-CREF. In 2003, he was named Chief Investment Officer, with responsibility for the investment policy, strategy and stewardship of the company's equity and fixed income portfolios. Previously, Mr. Evans headed CREF Investments, where he oversaw the firm's equity portfolios and directed TIAA-CREF's global analysts and portfolio managers. Mr. Evans joined TIAA-CREF in 1985 as an investment analyst.

Mr. Evans is a member of the New York Society of Security Analysts and holds the Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) designation. He serves on the Board of Trustees of Barnard College and co-chairs Barnard's investment committee. He is a member of the Dean's Advisory Council at Northwestern University's Kellogg School of Management, the Tufts University Investment Committee and chairs the investment committee for the Rockefeller Family Fund.
