This letter is submitted in reference to The Depository Trust Company (“DTC”) rule filing filed with the Commission under File No. SR-DTC-2013-11 (the “Rule Filing”). “Globally Locked Eligible Securities continue to be Eligible Securities unless and until DTC makes a determination under its Rules to terminate eligibility, as to which DTC Rule 22, Right to Contest Decisions, would apply; alternatively, those securities may be held in custody only at DTC, as provided in the DTC Rules and Procedures applicable to custody only, i.e., not for book-entry transfer and asset services applicable to Eligible Securities. *See generally*
