

SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION NEWS DIGEST

A brief summary of financial proposals filed with and actions by the S.E.C.

PROXY RULE COMMENT DATE EXTENDED. The SEC has granted a further extension, from January 15 to February 15, 1965, for the filing of views and comments upon the proposed amendments to its proxy rules published December 7, 1964 in Release 34-7481. The extension was granted at the request of persons who desire additional time in which to submit comments on the proposed amendments.

NEES RECEIVES ORDER. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act (Release 35-15175) authorizing the New England Electric System, Boston, to sell 698,227 additional common shares to stockholders at the rate of one new share for each 20 shares held, to offer any unsubscribed shares to its employees, and then to offer any remaining shares at competitive bidding. NEES will apply the net proceeds from the stock sale to construction programs of its subsidiaries, either through loans or the purchase of additional shares of their capital stocks.

NINETEEN CORP. SEEKS ORDER. The Nineteen Corporation, 20 Exchange Pl., New York, has applied to the SEC for an order under the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company; and the Commission has issued an order (Release IC-4146) giving interested persons until February 11 to request a hearing thereon. The application indicates that the company was dissolved on November 18, 1964, pursuant to a plan of complete liquidation.

BOOTH PRODUCTIONS PROPOSES OFFERING. Stephen F. Booth Productions, 191 Brady Lane, Bloomfield Hills, Mich., filed a registration statement (File 2-23097) with the SEC on January 18 seeking registration of \$450,000 of Limited Partnership interests, to be offered for public sale in 150 units (at \$3,000 per unit plus a possible 20% overcall) by Stephen F. Booth and Frederick G. Bahr, the General Partners, the partnership is to be formed under Michigan law for the purpose of producing the motion picture "Brighty", which is the story of a burro which lived in the Grand Canyon during the early part of the twentieth century. The motion picture is to be based on the book "Brighty of the Grand Canyon" by Marquerite Henry and will be directed by Norman Foster. The business of the partnership is to be conducted by the General Partners.
