ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ARTHUR H. ROSS, OTHERS

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 (SIPA) against Arthur H. Ross, Leslie Dubitsky and Laris Milonas, the President and Director; Executive Vice-President, Treasurer and Director; and Executive Vice-President, Secretary and Director, respectively, of Hanover Square Securities Group, Inc., a broker-dealer and member of the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. headquartered in New York City.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that during various periods from about July 1983 to about December 1983, Ross, Dubitsky and Milonas aided and abetted violations by Hanover Square of the net capital, customer protection, bookkeeping, financial reporting and supplemental reporting rules under the Exchange Act. The Order also alleges that Hanover Square, by consent, was placed in liquidation under SIPA on December 15, 1983. A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against respondents are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial sanctions would be appropriate. (Rel. 34-21660)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSE-84-14) to modify MSE rules (Article XX, Rule 8) to prohibit MSE specialists using Autoquote from disseminating a bid and/or offer that is more than 1/8 point away from the Intermarket Trading System market.
