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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### CLASSIFICATION AND DECLASSIFICATION OF NATIONAL SECURITY INFORMATION AND MATERIAL

The Commission is amending its regulation which designates the senior agency official responsible for ensuring appropriate implementation of Executive Order 12356, "National Security Information" and its implementing directive, Information Security Oversight Office Directive No. 1. These documents establish procedures and criteria for classifying, declassifying and safeguarding national security information. The amendments reflect the transfer of the responsibility for information security from the Secretary of the Commission to the Executive Director. (Rel. 33-6624)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### SONOMA INTERNATIONAL NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on February 5 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Sonoma International of Culver City, California. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a judgment of permanent injunction and other equitable relief.

The Commission alleges that Sonoma, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended June 30, 1985, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended September 30, 1985, filed late Annual and Quarterly Reports and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Sonoma to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### CITICORP

An order has been issued as of February 3 under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Citicorp that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing, previously qualified indentures, and two Pooling and Servicing Agreements dated October 1, 1985 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company as trustee. ## ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
