CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

GARY M. WOZNIAK PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 29 Judge George LaPlata, Eastern District of Michigan, preliminarily enjoined Gary M. Wozniak from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, after an evidentiary hearing. Judge LaPlata also order that Wozniak's assets be frozen and that he provide an accounting to the Court.

The Commission's August 28, 1987 Complaint alleges that, as part of a fraudulent scheme, Wozniak offered and sold securities to investors, requiring them to make their checks payable to a Wozniak personal bank account for the purchase of securities. Thereafter, Wozniak failed to process the orders. The Complaint further alleges that defendant misappropriated hundreds of thousands of dollars in connection with failing to process the orders. On August 28, 1987, Judge LaPlata had entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Wozniak in this matter. (SEC v. Gary M. Wozniak, Eastern Division of Michigan, Civil Action No. 87-60283). MILTON MARKS, OTHERS HELD IN CIVIL CONTEMPT

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 26 U.S. District Court Judge Marvin E. Aspen entered orders finding Milton Marks, William Kouris, and Overland Transfer Agency Corp. in civil contempt for their failure to comply with previously entered orders of disgorgement against them.

The contempt orders provide that each defendant pay \$100 per day for each day they fail to comply with the disgorgement orders and that Marks and Kouris be imprisoned if they fail to comply within 21 days, until they do comply. On April 28, 1987, Marks was ordered to disgorge an amount not less than \$3,226,500 while Kouris and Overland were ordered to disgorge a total of \$165,000. The Court had earlier entered Default Judgments in the same matter permanently enjoining Marks, Kouris, and Overland from violating registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws based upon their conduct in the offer and sale of the securities of Continental Energy Corporation. (SEC v. Milton Marks, et al, NDIL, Civil Action No. 86 C 7401). (LR-11665)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOETTCHER VENTURE CAPITAL PARTNERS II, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Boettcher Venture Capital Partners II, L.P. (Partnership), Boettcher Venture Management, L.P. (Managing General Partner), and Boettcher & Company, Inc. (Management Company) determining that: (1) the Independent General Partners of the Partnership are not "interested persons" of the Partnership, the Managing General Partner or the Management Company solely by reason of their status as general partners of the Partnership or Boettcher Venture Capital Partners I, L.P. (BVCP I); (2) service as an Independent General Partner of the Partnership will not cause an independent general partner of BVCP I to be "interested person" of BVCP I; and (3) Limited Partners with less than a 5% ownership interest in the Partnership will not be "affiliated persons" of the Partnership or its partners solely by reason of their status as Limited Partners. OXFORD ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION; OXFORD ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION III
