RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION S-K, FORM 8-K, AND SCHEDULE 14A ADOPTED

The Commission adopted certain amendments to Regulation S-K, Form 8-K, and Schedule 14A regarding disclosure of registrants' changes in certifying accountants. The amendments are effective 30 days after publication in the Federal Register. (Rel. 33-6766)

COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSAL TO INCREASE TIMELINESS OF FORM 8-K DISCLOSURES

The Commission issued a release publishing for comment proposals to increase the timeliness of disclosures on Form 8-K for registrants reporting changes in certifying accountants or resignations of directors. Interested persons should submit five copies of their comments to Jonathan G. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received on or before 30 days after publication of the release in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. S7-6-88. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

GLEN L. DAVISON APPOINTED DEPUTY CHIEF ACCOUNTANT

The Commission today announced the appointment of Glen L. Davison as the Commission's Deputy Chief Accountant. Mr. Davison succeeds Edmund Coulson who was named Chief Accountant in January.

As Deputy Chief Accountant, Mr. Davison will share with the Chief Accountant the role of principal adviser to the Commission on accounting and auditing matters. Mr. Davison has been actively involved in the Commission's programs designed to ensure full and fair disclosure. In announcing the appointment, Mr. Coulson said, "Glen has proven to have outstanding technical and managerial skills, and we look forward to his playing an increasingly important role in dealing with the important policy issues in accounting and auditing." TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF BALBOA DEVELOPMENT, INC.; ELI SCIENTIFIC, INC.

The Commission announced two single ten-day suspensions of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Balboa Development, Inc., an Oregon corporation with offices in San Francisco, California; and Eli Scientific, Inc., also an Oregon corporation with offices in Covina, California, for the periods beginning at 1:00 p.m. (EDT) on April 13 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on April 22.

The Commission suspended trading in Balboa's and Eli's securities because of a lack of current and accurate public information about their financial condition and results of their operations; their total assets; their revenues and net income; and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning these matters. (Rel. 34-25583-Balboa; 34-25584-Eli)

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF GOLDCOR, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Goldcor, Inc., a Delaware corporation, for the period beginning at 9:00 a.m. (EDT) on April 14 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on April 23. The Commission suspended trading in Goldcor's securities in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning the nature of Goldcor's assets and business operations. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FP MPT PARTNERS

An order has been issued on an application filed by FB MPT Partners, a New York general partnership organized for employees of, or persons providing services on retainer to, First Boston, Inc. and its affiliates (the Partnership), exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act except Sections 9, 17(a) and 17(d) (with certain exceptions), 36(a) and 36(b), and 37 through 53. NATIONWIDE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nationwide Life Insurance Company, Nationwide Variable Account-3, and American Capital Marketing, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of Variable Account-3 in connection with the issuance of certain variable annuity contracts. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Securities Stock Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-88-1) that would authorize it to provide clearing services for foreign securities. (Rel. 34-25575)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-87-22) that would give it greater flexibility in dealing with financially troubled clearing members and responding to clearing member insolvencies. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 11. (Rel. 34-25576)
