CHANGE IN WEEKLY CALENDAR

Time and place of the hearing scheduled for Wednesday, June 22 (announced yesterday) may be subject to change. The hearing is being held by the Subcommittee on Telecommunications and Finance on insider trading; David S. Ruder is scheduled to testify.

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF HIEX DEVELOPMENT USA, INC.

The Commission announced a single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Hiex Development USA, Inc., a Nevada corporation most recently headquartered in Lakewood, Colorado, for the period beginning at 12:00 p.m. (EDT) on June 20, 1988, and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on June 29, 1988. The Commission suspended trading of the securities of Hiex because of a lack of current and accurate information concerning, among other things, the valuation of Hiex's assets, substantial purchase commitments, oil and gas reserve data, and the Company's financial and operating history. TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF 24 ISSUERS

The Commission announced a single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Agritronix, Inc., America's Pro Players, Inc., Armtek, Inc., Bio-Medican Corp., Capital Investment Services, Inc., Compu-Vision, Inc., Consolidated Funding Services, Inc., Duralite Manufacturing Co., E-Lite Technologies, Inc., Engine Dynamics, Inc., Feliz Industries, Inc., FireGold Corp., Growlnola, Inc., ITEX Barter Systems, Inc., Lens Care, Inc., Mandella Corporation, Inc., Omni Capital Corp., Paradise International Pictures, Inc., PenCo, Inc., ReCom, Inc., Sportek International, Inc., TetraValent, Inc., Vertex Information, Inc., and Wee Win Toys, Inc., for the period beginning at 9:00 a.m. (EDT) on June 21, 1988, and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on June 30, 1988. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of the aforementioned companies in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the corporate histories and financial conditions of the companies, the identities of their shareholders and claims for exemption from the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 made by these companies and pursuant to which their securities are trading. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM A. CALVO, III, ENJOINED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on June 8, Judge Peter C. Dorsey, U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against William A. Calvo, III, pursuant to the Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment. The Order enjoins Calvo from violating various antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The Commission had charged Calvo and nine other defendants in connection with the fraudulent 1985 closing of The Electronics Warehouse, Inc. in a Complaint dated March 14, 1986. The Complaint alleged that the defendants had improperly extended the \$1.2 million "mini-maxi" offering for two weeks past the disclosed deadline, that the defendants had failed to disclose the fact that the issuer's president was indicted for mail fraud during the offering period, and that the defendants had fraudulently closed the offering by obtaining \$690,000 in short term loans that were repaid from the offering's proceeds. The other nine defendants previously consented to permanent injunctions. (SEC v. The Electronics Warehouse, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. H-86-282 (PCD), USDC District of Connecticut) (LR-11772)

CONTEMPT MOTION AGAINST ROBERT A. DIANNI DENIED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on June 10, the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts (the Honorable A. David Mazzone) denied the Commission's Motion for Judgment of Contempt against Robert A. DiIanni of Boston. After three days of hearings, the Court found that DiIanni was unable to comply with the Court's Order of Disgorgement entered on April 13, which required DiIanni to disgorge to the Court \$3,719,990. DUANE MARKUS, JACK PAGEL AND PAGEL, INC. ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on April 8 and May 26, the Honorable Diane E. Murphy, United States District Court Judge for the District of Minnesota entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Duane Markus as well as Jack Pagel and his company, Pagel, Inc., respectively. The injunctions enjoin these defendants from further violations of the antifraud, underwriting and books and records provisions of the securities laws.

The Commission's Complaint had alleged that in connection with Pagel, Inc.'s, a registered broker-dealer in Minneapolis, Minnesota, underwriting of the initial public offering of Filmtec Corporation stock these defendants, among others, failed to make a bona fide distribution of these shares to the public prior to Pagel, Inc.'s making a market in the stock. Further, the Complaint alleged that during two separate time periods in the aftermarket trading, these defendants were involved in a manipulation of the market of Filmtec Corporation stock. Previously, in a related administrative proceeding against Marcus, Pagel and Pagel, Inc., the United States District Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit upheld the Commission's findings of these same violations as well as Pagel's and Markus' permanent bars and Pagel, Inc.'s registration revocation. COMPLAINT NAMES SCOPUS TECHNOLOGY COMPANY, INC.

The Commission announced that on June 21, it filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Scopus Technology Company, Inc., of New York, New York. Scopus is engaged in research, development and engineering of new product technologies oriented to the medical and engineering markets. The Commission in its complaint alleges that Scopus violated the reporting provisions of the federal securities laws in that Scopus failed to file its Annual Reports for its fiscal years ended December 31, 1986 and 1987, its Quarterly Report for its fiscal quarter ended March 31, 1988, and filed late two Annual Reports and two Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission seeks a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction restraining and enjoining Scopus from failing to comply with the reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and requiring Scopus to file promptly its delinquent reports. (SEC v. Scopus Technology Company, Inc., USDC District of Columbia, Civil Action No. 88-1684-HHG) (LR-11775)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HOME GROUP TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 6 to request a hearing on an application for an order under Section 6(c) of the Act from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d), and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to permit Home Group Trust to assess a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of its shares and to waive such charge under certain conditions, and for an order under Section 11(a) to permit the Applicant's funds to exchange shares on a basis other than net asset value. SUN LIFE FINANCE CORPORATION, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sun Life Finance Corporation for an order permitting it to offer and sell non-voting preferred stock to finance the business operations of its parent and subsidiaries thereof. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
