
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PAUL GOLDBERG DEFAULTS

In administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Commission issued Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default against Paul Goldberg. Goldberg failed to answer the Order Instituting Proceedings and therefore was in default.

On the basis of the Order, the Commission found that Goldberg: (1) on April 21, 1987, was convicted of conspiracy and mail fraud in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York; (2) consented to a permanent injunction in the same District Court restraining him from further mail and wire fraud activities, and also enjoining him for five years from offering for sale any security or commodity by means of telephone or direct mail solicitation; and (3) was permanently enjoined in the N.Y. Supreme Court from violations of various provisions of the New York State General Business Law and Executive Law, and from any fraudulent offering or sale of securities.

The Commission ordered that Goldberg be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-25994)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PALMER FINANCIAL CORPORATION, OTHERS IN CONTEMPT; PATTINSON HAYTON SUBJECT TO FINES

The Commission announced that on August 18 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered Findings of Civil Contempt against Palmer Financial Corporation, Galloway Capital Corporation, and Pattinson Hayton, Chairman of the Board and President of Palmer and Galloway, and entered a Stipulated Order Imposing Sanctions against Hayton.

The Court found that defendants had failed to comply with its Final Judgments entered on May 20 which ordered the filing of Palmer's delinquent reports and Galloway's Schedule 13D by June 1. The Court subjected Hayton to three separate \$1,000 per day fines (1) if Galloway fails to file its Schedule 13D by August 25; (2) if Hayton fails to file his Forms 4 by August 25, or fails to disclaim ownership and control over defendants L & P Holdings, Ltd. and Montaigne Trust or to cause them to file their Forms 3 and 4 and Schedules 13D by September 9; and (3) if Palmer fails to file its delinquent reports by September 30. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LIFETIME GOLD & PRECIOUS METALS TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by various mutual funds within the MFS Lifetime Investment Program and MFS Financial Services amending a prior order [Rel. IC-15555, January 28, 1987] permitting the assessment and waiver of a contingent deferred sales load, and approving certain exchange offers. (Rel. IC-16529 - Aug. 17)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, to extend from August 31, 1988 to February 28, 1989 its guarantee of System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), its subsidiary, obligations under an amended Restated and Amended Fuel Lease under which SERI leases from Port Gibson Energy, Inc. the nuclear fuel used to satisfy a portion of the fuel requirements of Unit No. 1 at SERI's Grand Gulf Nuclear Generating Station. FLEET/NORSTAR FINANCIAL GROUP, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 6 to request a hearing on an application by Fleet/Norstar Financial Group, Inc., a Rhode Island corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A. under six Fleet/Norstar indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Citibank from acting as trustee under such indentures. The indentures are dated October 1, 1981, September 1, 1983, April 1, 1984, August 1, 1984, and August 1, 1984 (each supplemented as of January 1, 1988), and February 15, 1986, and the securities outstanding under them are approximately \$36 million of non-assignable debentures (The Oneida National Bank and Trust Company of Central New York Series); \$42 million of non-assignable debentures (Security New York State Corporation Series); \$60 million of debentures, due May 1, 2014, and \$65 million of 7-year notes; \$9 million of non-assignable debentures (Bank of Long Island, N.A. Series); \$13 million of non-assignable debentures (Banc of Maine Corporation Series); and \$75 million of notes, due March 1, 1991, \$50 million of Notes, due January 20, 1997, \$125 million of notes, due July 15, 1992, and \$50 million of notes, due September 1, 1992, respectively.
