EXCHANGE COMMISSION

COMMENTS REQUESTED ON RULE 144A

The Commission yesterday published for comment Rule 144A, which would provide a safe harbor from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 for resale of securities to institutional investors. The Commission also yesterday published for comment amendments to Rules 144 and 145, under which the time that must elapse before public resale of restricted securities would be defined to commence when the securities are sold by the issuer or its affiliate.

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

General Counsel Daniel L. Goelzer today announced that the Commission filed, at the invitation of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, a friend-of-the-court brief in Wilson v. Ruffa & Hanover, P.C. The case involves the question of whether, under the Supreme Court's recent decision in Pinter v. Dahl, 108 S. Ct. 2063 (1988), a law firm may be held liable in a rescission action under Section 12(2) of the Securities Act, either as a "statutory seller" or as an aider and abettor, when the firm's only involvement in the securities transaction at issue was the preparation of the allegedly false offering materials and the sending of the materials to several prospective buyers, including the plaintiff, at the request of the issuer. The brief concludes that the law firm cannot be so held liable. In addition, the brief states that a Section 12(2) plaintiff should not be required to provide causation. (Press Release 88-104)

THOMAS S. HARMAN APPOINTED CHIEF COUNSEL, DIVISION OF INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT

Kathryn B. McGrath, Director of the Division of Investment Management, announced that Thomas B. Harman has been appointed Chief Counsel of the Division, effective immediately. He replaces Mary Podesta, who was named an Associate Director of the Division.

Mr. Harman joined the Commission's staff in 1982. In 1985 he was named Special Counsel in the Office of Chief Counsel and in 1986 became Special Counsel in the Division's Office of Disclosure and Adviser Regulation. He was promoted to chief of that office in 1987. Mr. Harman received his B.A. degree, magna cum laude, from Duke University in 1979, a J.D. from the University of Virginia in 1982, and an L.L.M. from Georgetown University in 1988.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ACACIA CAPITAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Acacia Capital Corporation (Fund), Acacia National Variable Life Insurance Account B, and certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts (collectively, Applicants). The application requests an order exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit mixed and shared funding. FINANCIAL HORIZONS INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been on an application filed by Financial Horizons Investment Trust and Nationwide Financial Services, Inc. granting an exemption from certain provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit the Trust to impose a contingent deferred sales charge. (Rel. IC-16608 - Oct. 25)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES; MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 14 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24731, dated October 20: NORTHEAST UTILITIES - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, The Quinnehtuk Company, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, The Rocky River Realty Company, and Holyoke Water Power Company, whereby these companies seek separate authority to issue short-term notes to the system's money pool and/or banks, to issue and sell commercial paper, to acquire short-term notes, and to make open account advances through December 31, 1990; and MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC. - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, and New Orleans Public Service Inc., for SERI to issue and sell up to \$400 million aggregate principal amount of its first mortgage bonds in one or more series from time to time through October 31, 1990. In order to provide additional security for the bonds, SERI may assign certain rights under an Availability Agreement with SERI's associate electric utility companies and under a Capital Funds Agreement with Middle South.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers: (SR-NASD-88-30) to amend the definition of qualified independent underwriter in Section 2(1) of Schedule E to its By-Laws. (Rel. 34-26214); and (SR-NASD-88-20) to amend Article VII, Section 1 of its By-Laws to require members to provide the NASD with comparison and other trade data as may be required by the Board of Governors. (Rel. 34-26215)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission temporarily approved two a proposed rule changes filed by the Midwest Clearing Corporation. The proposals (SR-MCC-87-5 and 88-7) establish Fund/Serv, the appropriate clearing fund contributions for participants based upon their Fund/Serv Activity, and related procedures to process mutual fund transactions. The temporary approval will expire on January 31, 1989. (Rel. 34-26216)
