ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST SELIGMAN SECURITIES, INC.

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Seligman Securities, Inc.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that Registrant wilfully violated the reserve requirements of the customer protection rule in that its Special Reserve Bank Account for the Exclusive Benefit of Customers contained substantial deficiencies in June and July 1987. It also alleges that in August 1987, Registrant failed to obtain and thereafter maintain possession and control of its customers' fully paid and excess margin securities. It further alleges that Registrant filed an inaccurate financial reporting form with the New York Stock Exchange. Finally, it alleges that from about December 1986 to about September 1987, Registrant failed to keep current and accurate its books and records and failed to give immediate telegraphic notice to the Commission of its failure to make and keep current and accurate books and records.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether these allegations are true, and, if so, to decide what remedial action, if any, is appropriate. (Rel. 34-26296)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST HITECK INTERNATIONAL PRODUCTS, INC. AND RICK D. VAN VLEET

The Denver Regional Office announced that on November 17 the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Hiteck International Products, Inc., a Colorado corporation, and its former president, Rick D. Van Vleet, from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Order was entered by consent of the defendants without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint. The Final Order of Permanent Injunction prohibits defendants from, among other things, making untrue statements of material fact with regard to the business operations, financial condition or future prospects of Hiteck (and with regard to the injunction against Van Vleet, any other issuer), its affiliates or subsidiaries, or omitting to state facts necessary to make any statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.

The Complaint alleged that defendants utilized a materially false prospectus in an initial public offering which failed to accurately disclose the financial condition of Hiteck and Hiteck's intended use of proceeds. (SEC v. Hiteck International Products, Inc. and Rick D. Van Vleet, USDC CO, Civil Action No. 88-M-1555). (LR-11920)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE GUARDIAN GENERATION SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Guardian Generation Series Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16650 - Nov. 23)

T.H. LEE ACQUISITION FUND II, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by T.H. Lee Acquisition Fund II, L.P., T.H. Lee Acquisition Fund (Retirement Accounts) II, L.P. (collectively, the Partnerships), and Thomas H. Lee Advisors II, L.P. (Adviser) determining that: (1) the Independent General Partners of the Partnerships are not "interested persons" within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, of the Partnerships, or the Adviser, and (2) limited partners who own less than 5% equity interest in a Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" (as defined by Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Act) of the Partnership or its partners solely by reason of their status as limited partners. (Rel. IC-16651 - Nov. 23)

ML OKLAHOMA VENTURE PARTNERS, LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

An order has been issued on an application filed by ML Oklahoma Venture Partners, Limited Partnership (the Partnership), ML OK Co., Limited Partnership (the Managing General Partner), and Merrill Lynch Venture Capital Inc. (the Management Company) (collectively, Applicants) determining that (1) the Independent General Partners (as hereinafter defined) of the Partnership are not "interested persons" of the Partnership, the Managing General Partner, or the Management Company by reason of being general partners of the Partnership and co-partners of the Managing General Partner, and (2) persons who become limited partners (the Limited Partners) of the Partnership who own less than 5% of the limited partnership interests in a Partnership will not be "affiliated persons" of the Partnership or any of its other partners solely by reason of their status as Limited Partners. MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.; YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY;
SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY; EASTERN EDISON COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24749, dated November 17: MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC. - a registered holding company, its subsidiaries, MSU System Services, Inc., Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, New Orleans Public Service Inc., System Fuels, Inc., and System Energy Resources, Inc., to continue a system money pool and to sell short-term notes to banks and commercial paper dealers from time to time through December 31, 1990; YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY - subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell through December 31, 1990 up to \$25 million outstanding at any one time of its short-term promissory notes; SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to sell 2,882 utility poles to South Central Bell Telephone Company; and EASTERN EDISON COMPANY - Montaup Electric Company, Blackstone Valley Electric Company, and EUA Service Corporation (Service), subsidiaries of Eastern Utilities Associates, whereby the subsidiaries will issue and sell short-term notes, through December 27, 1989, each in the aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time not to exceed \$45 million for Eastern, \$40 million for Montaup, \$14 million for Blackstone, and \$5 million for Service.

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of four issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-26305)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes filed by The New York Stock Exchange: (SR-NYSE-88-27) that will add a broadened conflict of interest provision to its rules providing that no person shall participate in the adjudication of any matter in which he is personally interested. (Rel. 34-26302); and (SR-NYSE-87-9) to reinstate into its Constitution a conflict of interest provision prohibiting members of its Board of Directors from participating in the adjudication of any matter in which they have a personal interest. (Rel. 34-26303)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-9) that amends its Constitution to create a new "inactive member" membership category. This will permit natural persons who are not registered broker-dealers to purchase a PSE membership for the purpose of leasing that seat to a qualified PSE member. It will also permit a PSE member to choose a natural person to inherit his or her membership upon the member's death. (Rel. 34-26304)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-MCC-88-12) establishes an MCC special account, known as an "O account," to facilitate Regional Interface Organization processing of executions for non-MCC participants. (Rel. 34-26306)
