RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

REVISED SECTION 16 RULES AND PROVISIONS REPROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission is repropounding for public comment amendments to its rules, forms, and issuer disclosure requirements relating to the reporting and short-swing profit recovery provisions of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and related provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS CONCLUDED, FINDINGS MADE AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST PROFILE INVESTMENTS CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Commission concluded administrative proceedings, made findings and imposed sanctions against Profile Investments Corporation, Robert Schlien of Coral Springs, Florida and president of Profile, and Carlos Fontecilla of Miami, Florida and former vice president of Profile. Profile was a broker-dealer registered with the Commission with offices in Miami and Fort Lauderdale, Florida; Atlanta, Georgia; Chicago, Illinois; and New York City, New York. The Commission simultaneously accepted Respondents' Offer of Settlement.

The Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions contains findings that (1) Respondents sold certain securities at excessive, undisclosed mark-ups over the prevailing market price of the securities; (2) Profile, aided and abetted by Schlien and Fontecilla, provided customers with false written confirmations; and (3) Profile, aided and abetted by Schlien and Fontecilla, failed to accurately time stamp order tickets.

In accordance with the Offer, the Commission ordered that Schlien and Fontecilla be barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company, provided that they may reapply to become so associated after 18 months, and Profile's registration as a broker-dealer be revoked. SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST JAMES P. HOLLIS, JR.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against James Paul Hollis, Jr. and simultaneously accepted his Offer of Settlement. Hollis consented, without admitting or denying the allegations, to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions. The Order bars Hollis from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser.

In its Order, the Commission found that Hollis wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 as well as the registration provision of the Advisers Act. From approximately March 1983 to October 1988, Hollis, a registered representative of Southmark Financial Services, Inc., advised clients to purchase securities but misappropriated for his own use funds paid to him for the purchase of securities, totalling \$494,275.71. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JUDGMENT/PROCEEDING ENTERED
AGAINST J. CHRISTOPHER RODENO

On August 3, Judge Mahos from the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Ohio entered judgment in SEC v. Howard Passov, et al, filed July 24, 1989 [see LR-12174]. Subsequent to entry of Judgment in that matter, the Commission instituted separate administrative proceedings against J. Christopher Rodeno under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, Rodeno offered an Offer of Settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings.

In accepting the Rodeno's Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Rodeno had been permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Ohio from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5.

Based upon these findings, the Commission ordered that Rodeno is suspended from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company for six months. (LR-12215; see 34-27133)

RAYMOND F. DADDARIO, JR. ENJOINED,
ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT AND INTEREST

The Boston Regional Office announced that on July 31 Judge Arthur H. Nevas, U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Raymond F. Daddario, Jr., enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, and ordering him to disgorge \$11,490 in profits and to pay an Insider Trading Sanction Act penalty of \$11,490. Daddario consented to the Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleged that during July 1986, Daddario purchased stock in Coastal Savings Bank while in possession of material nonpublic information relating to a proposed merger offer between Suffield Savings Bank and Coastal. (SEC v. Raymond F. Daddario, Jr., DCT, Civil Action No. H-89-477-AHN). (LR-12217)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SECURITY FIRST LEGAL RESERVE FUND, INC.;
SECURITY FIRST MONEY MARKET FUND, INC.

Orders have been issued declaring that Security First Legal Reserve Fund, Inc.; and Security First Money Market Fund, Inc. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17110; IC-17111 - Aug. 15)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue and sell from time to time through December 31, 1990 up to \$375 million of medium-term securities as first mortgage bonds. (Rel. 35-24939 - Aug. 16)

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, to pay a portion of its outside directors' compensation in the form of NEES common shares. The order further authorizes NEES, from time to time through May 1, 1999, to purchase on the open market its common shares, not exceeding in the aggregate 20,000 shares, and pay said shares to its outside directors as such compensation. (Rel. 35-24940 - Aug. 16)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed proposed rule changes which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: The Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-89-13) which modifies its interim accounting procedures for the allocation of large cash distributions and extraordinary cash dividends so that payments relating to such cash distributions can be allocated by DTC on the payable date. (Rel. 34-27122); and The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-18) to permit the earlier redemption of due-bills that represent large cash dividends. (Rel. 34-27124)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-30) to permit member affiliates to serve as trustees of the Stock Exchange Fund. (Rel. 34-27123)
