FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT RELEASES

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT APPEAL OF DAVID C. GROSSACK

The General Counsel sent a letter to David C. Grossack, Esquire, in response to his appeal of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Officer's determination to deny access to certain investigative records under FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A). The General Counsel determined that production of certain documents responsive to the request could reasonably be expected to interfere with government law enforcement proceedings. (FOIA Rel. 160)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST V.F. MINTON SECURITIES AND VERNON F. MINTON

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against V.F. Minton Securities, Inc., a registered broker/dealer located in Fort Worth, Texas, and Vernon F. Minton, its principal. The Order for Public Proceedings alleges that the Respondents violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Specifically, Respondents are alleged to have sold approximately 700,000 shares of unregistered stock in U.S. Assurance Corporation through the use of false, misleading and incomplete statements of material facts concerning the ownership, financial condition and business prospects of the company.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford the respondents an opportunity to present any defenses. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial action should be ordered by the Commission. (Rel. 34- 28457)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT AGAINST JEFFREY GEE AND ASSET GROWTH MANAGEMENT

The Chicago Regional Office announced that, on September 25, it filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court, Southern District of Indiana, against Jeffrey L. Gee, a registered investment adviser, and Asset Growth Management, Inc., a registered investment adviser of which Gee is the controlling shareholder. The complaint seeks

to enjoin them from violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and the reporting, books and records, and other provisions of the Investment Advisers Act. The complaint also seeks an order requiring the defendants to disgorge all funds received from Gee's misappropriation of investor funds.

The complaint alleges that Gee misappropriated approximately \$1,000,000 from Asset Growth clients by various means, including the preparation of false account statements and the use of forged bank documents. In addition, the complaint alleges that Gee misappropriated approximately \$425,000 from investors in two limited partnerships by falsely representing that the funds were used to purchase certain real estate. Based on this conduct, Gee pled guilty in January 1990 to State charges of securities fraud and theft, receiving a ten year prison sentence. [SEC v. Jeffrey L. INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST MALIBU CAPITAL CORPORATION

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on September 25, the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District for the District of Columbia against Malibu Capital Corporation (Malibu), located in Torrance, California.

The complaint alleges that Malibu filed a misleading Annual Report with the Commission on Form 10-K for its Fiscal Year ended December 31, 1986, violating Sections 13(a) and 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act (Exchange Act) and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 15d-1 thereunder, by falsely stating that its financial statements were presented in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, when in fact its financial statements overstated its consolidated assets by 103%. The complaint also alleges that Malibu failed to file and to timely file required Annual and Quarterly Reports and Notifications of Late Filing, violating Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-25, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. The complaint seeks entry of an order permanently enjoining Malibu from future violations of Sections 13(a) and 15(d) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 12b-25, 13a-1, 13a-13, 15d-1 and 15d-13 thereunder, and issuance of an order requiring defendant Malibu forthwith to file with the Commission its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports. JOEL M. COUNTY CONSENTS TO INJUNCTION

The Commission announced the filing, on September 27, of a Complaint for Permanent Injunction in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado against Joel M. County (County), alleging that he violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Complaint alleges that County, while an assistant manager at the Fort Collins, Colorado branch office of Power Securities Corporation, implemented a number of fraudulent sales practices at the direction of Power's senior management. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, County consented to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction permanently enjoining him from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

QUEST FOR VALUE CASH MANAGEMENT TRUST GARDNER MANAGED ASSET TRUST

Orders have been issued on applications filed by the following under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies: QUEST FOR VALUE CASH MANAGEMENT TRUST and GARDNER MANAGED ASSET TRUST. SOCIETE GENERALE

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Societe Generale under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Societe Generale from all provisions of the Act to permit it to issue and sell in the United States any type of its equity securities, either directly or in the form of American Depository Shares represented by American Depository Receipts. (Rel. IC-17760; International Series Rel. No. 158 - September 27)

COLONIAL ADVANCED STRATEGIES GOLD TRUST

A conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act has been issued on an application filed by Colonial Advanced Strategies Gold Trust, et al. The order grants an exemption from the provisions of Section 12 (d)(3) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit applicants to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-17764 - September 27)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-89-16) to list for trading a new index option contract based on the Japan Index, a broad-based index of Japanese stocks that are traded on the Tokyo Stock Exchange. Publication of the approval is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 1. (Rel. 34-28475)
