U.S SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

IMPENDING CHANGE IN THE 6(b) FEE CALCULATION PERCENTAGE

Registrants should be aware that the conference report on the SEC's 1994 appropriation, which is now pending before Congress, changes the filing fee rate pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 to 1/29th of one percent from the current fee rate of 1/32nd of one percent. This new rate will be affective immediately upon its enactment, and any subsequent 6(b) filings paid at the old rate will not be accepted. The Commission will monitor this legislation and make an immediate announcement once the bill is signed into law.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST PRUDENTIAL SECURITIES INCORPORATED

The Commission today announced that it has filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against Prudential Securities Incorporated (PSI), and that it has also instituted an administrative proceeding charging the firm with wide-ranging violations of the federal securities laws involving, among other things, PSI's sales practices and offer and sale of limited partnerships and other investments during the 1980's.

Simultaneous with the filing of the complaint and the institution of the administrative proceeding, and without admitting or denying the allegations therein, PSI consented to the entry of a Final Order of the federal district court requiring it to pay all valid claims presented through a court-supervised claims resolution process. PSI consented to pay \$330 million to establish a fund for the benefit of defrauded investors, and to pay all additional valid claims in excess of the \$330 million in the fund.

PSI also consented to the entry of a Commission Order that imposes a \$10 million penalty on the firm and requires the firm to adopt remedial measures designed to prevent future violations of the federal securities laws. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MUTUAL OF AMERICA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 12, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Mutual of America Life Insurance Company and Mutual of America Separate Account No. 2 (Separate Account) for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The requested order would grant exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of an expense risk charge from the assets of the Separate Account. NEW ENGLAND MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d) and 27(e) and Rules 6e-2(b)(1),(b)(12),(b)(13)(i),(b)(13)(ii),(b)(13)(iii),(b)(13)(iv),(b)(13)(v),(b)(13)(vii), (c)(1) and (c)(4) and 22c-1 and 27e-1 thereunder to permit New England Mutual Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Separate Account (Variable Account), and New England Securities Corporation to issue certain limited payment variable life insurance policies that provide for: (i) a death benefit that will not always vary based on investment experience; (ii) bothe a sales charge deducted from premium payments and a contingent deferred sales charge; (iii) a contingent deferred administrative charge; (iv) deduction from the policy's account value for cost of insurance charges, charges for substandard mortality risks, automatic issue and incidentalinsurance benefits, and a minimum death benefit guarantee charge; (v) values and charges based on the 1980 Commissioners' Standards Ordinary Mortality Tables (the "1980 CSO Tables"); (vi) the holding of mutual fund shares funding the Variable Account without the use of a trustee, under an open account arrangement and without a trust indenture; and (vii) a waiver of notice of refund and withdrawal rights. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u>

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-AMEX-93-26) to provide standards for the listing of options on securities issued by registered closed-end management investment companies that invest in the securities of issuers located in particular foreign countries (International Funds). Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 25. (Rel. 34-33071; International Series Rel. 597)

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
