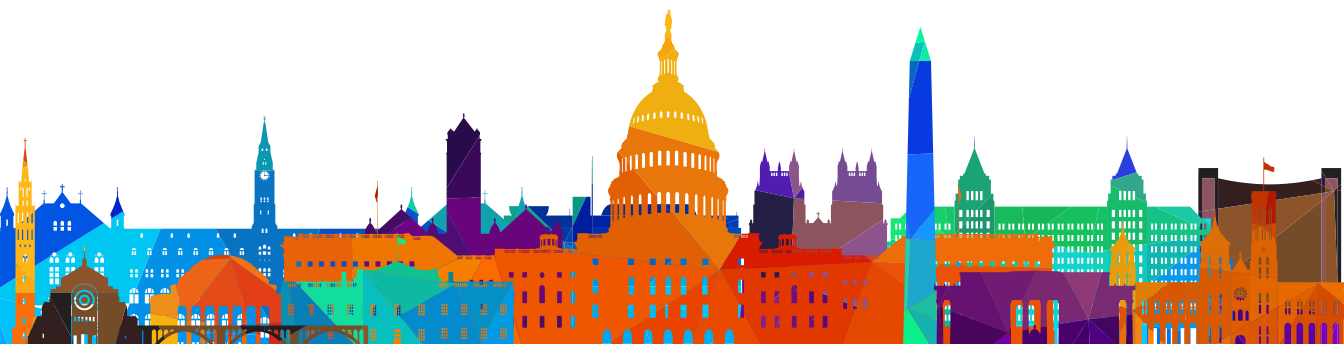


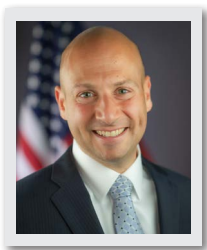
PRIDE in the Federal Workplace

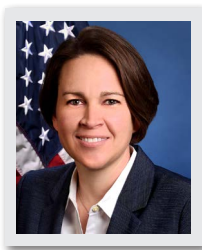
