Explanation: Revenue for the quarter ended September 30, 2005 is currently anticipated to be \$25.9 million, compared to \$19.1 million from the quarter ended September 30, 2004. For the nine months ended September 30, 2005 revenue is currently anticipated to be approximately \$53.5 million, compared to \$69.3 million for the nine months ended September 30, 2004. Net loss for the quarter ended September 30, 2005 is currently anticipated to be at \$49,000 which is \$1.1 million less than the net loss incurred in the quarter ended September 30, 2004.
