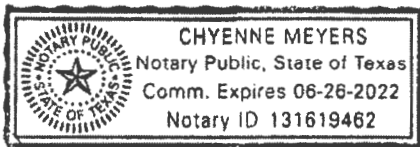

Note 1 - Nature of Business and Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Nature of Business:

Starlight Funding Investments, LLC, (Company), was organized in the State of Texas on November 30, 1999. The Company has adopted a calendar year.

The Company, located in Berkley, CA, is a broker and dealer in securities registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") and is a member of FINRA.

The Company operates pursuant to section (k)(2)(i) exemptive provisions of Rule 15c3-3 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and accordingly, is exempt from the remaining provisions of that Rule. The Company does not hold customer funds or securities, or perform custodial functions relating to customer securities. Under these exemptive provisions, the Computation for Determination of Reserve Requirements and Information Relating to the Possession and Control Requirements are not required.

Significant Accounting Policies:

The financial statements of the Company have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and accordingly reflect all significant receivables, payables, and other liabilities.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

The Company considers as cash all short-term investments with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

Accounts Receivable - Recognitions of Bad Debt

The Corporation considers accounts receivable to be fully collectible; accordingly, no allowance for doubtful accounts is required. If amounts become uncollectible, they will be charged to operations when that determination is made.

Revenue Recognition

The Company earns the commission through the private placement of debt and equity securities of corporation and other entities. The recognition and measurement of revenue is based on the assessment of individual contract terms. Significant judgment is required to determine when performance obligations are satisfied at a point in time or over time; when to recognize revenue based on the appropriate measure of the Company's progress under the contract; and whether constraints on variable consideration should be applied due to uncertain future events. Management believes that the performance obligation is satisfied on the closing date of a placement of securities because that is when the underlying financial instrument is identified, the pricing is agreed upon and the risks and rewards of ownership have been transferred to/from the customer.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of the assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Fair Value of Financial Instruments

The Company's financial asset and liability amounts reported in the statement of financial condition are short-term in nature and approximate fair value.

Income Taxes

The company was formed as a limited liability company and elected to be treated as a sole proprietorship for federal income tax purposes.

Concentrations

The company specializes in mergers and acquisitions, private capital formations, fairness opinions and business valuations.

Subsequent Events

Management has evaluated the Company's events and transactions that occurred subsequent to December 31, 2018, through February 27, 2020; the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

There were no events or transactions that occurred during this period that materially impacted the amounts or disclosures in the Company's financial statements.

Note 2 - Net Capital Requirements

The Company is subject to the SEC Uniform Net Capital Rule (Rule 15c3-1), which requires the maintenance of a minimum net capital and requires that the ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital, both as defined, shall not exceed 15 to 1. Rule 15c3-1 also provides that equity capital may not be withdrawn or cash dividends paid if the resulting net capital ratio would exceed 10 to 1. At December 31, 2019, the Company had net capital of \$25,186.88, which was \$20,186.88 in excess of its net capital requirement of \$5,000. The Company's net capital ratio was .66 to 1.

Note 3 - Possession of Control Requirements

The Company does not have any possession or control of customer's funds or securities. There was no material inadequacies in the procedures followed in adhering to the exemptive provision. Of SEC Rule 15c-3-3(k)(2)(i).

Note 4 - Contingencies

There are currently no asserted claims or legal proceedings against the Company, however, the nature of the Company's business subjects in the various claims, regulatory examinations, and other proceedings in the ordinary course of business. The ultimate outcome of any such action against the Company could have an adverse impact on the financial condition, results, of operations, or cash flows of the Company.

Note 5 - Rent

There was no rent expense in 2019.

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
