#### Positioning:

#### Best Case Scenario:

- If the Final Basket Level is greater than or equal to the Initial Basket Level, investors receive 100% of the performance of the Underlying at maturity, subject to a Maximum Return of between 13.30% and 16.30% (to be determined on the Trade Date).
- An investment in BUyS is not callable or averaged.

#### Worst Case Scenario:


