Item 4.02(a) Non-Reliance on Previously Issued Financial Statements or a Related Audit Report or Completed Interim Review (September 30, 2013 10-Q).

1. We note you disclose that HK Battery Technology, Inc. consulted with its accounting firm and concluded that previously issued financial statements as of September 30, 2013 should no longer be relied upon. Please tell us if you intended to state that Angstrom Holdings Corporation is the Company that is being discussed in your periodic report. If so, please amend and revise to disclose that Angstrom Holdings Corporation is in fact the company amending its interim financial statements. If not, please advise.

We urge all persons who are responsible for the accuracy and adequacy of the disclosure in the filing to be certain that the filing includes the information the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and all applicable Exchange Act rules require. Since the company and its management are in possession of all facts relating to a company's disclosure, they are responsible for the accuracy and adequacy of the disclosures they have made.

In responding to our comments, please provide a written statement from the company acknowledging that:

- the company is responsible for the adequacy and accuracy of the disclosure in the filing;
- staff comments or changes to disclosure in response to staff comments do not foreclose the Commission from taking any action with respect to the filing; and
- the company may not assert staff comments as a defense in any proceeding initiated by the Commission or any person under the federal securities laws of the United States.
