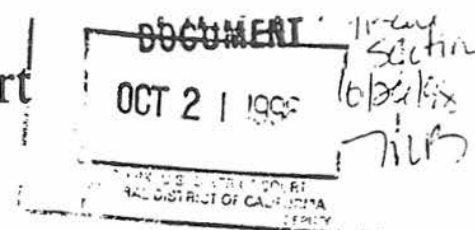

## Petition on Probation and Supervised Release (Modification)

COMES NOW ROBERT M. LATTA, CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OF THE COURT presenting an official report upon the conduct and attitude of Darryl Street who was placed on supervision by the Honorable GEORGE H. KING sitting in the court at Los Angeles, on the 10th day of January, 1996 who fixed the period of supervision at three years, and imposed the general terms and conditions theretofore adopted by the court and also imposed special conditions and terms as follows:

## RESPECTFULLY PRESENTING PETITION FOR ACTION OF COURT FOR CAUSE AS FOLLOWS:

Due to insufficient financial resources and earnings, Darryl Street has been unable, without undue hardship, to pay the restitution imposed in full prior to the scheduled expiration of supervision on January 9, 1999. The balance as of September 24, 1998, is \$18,200.00. Further, it appears unlikely that Darryl Street will, in the remaining supervision term, pay substantial amounts toward the financial obligation.

PRAYING THAT THE COURT WILL ORDER that supervision shall expire as scheduled on January 9, 1999, without full payment of restitution having been completed. However, Mr. Darryl Street shall remain responsible for the payment of the restitution ordered.
