REPORT OF INDEPENDENT REGISTERED PUBLIC ACCOUNTING FIRM

We have reviewed management's statements, included in the accompanying Brighthouse Securities, LLC's Exemption Report, in which (1) Brighthouse Securities, LLC identified the following provisions of 17 C.F.R. § 15c3-3(k) under which Brighthouse Securities, LLC claimed an exemption from 17 C.F.R. § 240.15c3-3: paragraph (k)(1), (the "exemption provisions") and (2) Brighthouse Securities, LLC stated that Brighthouse Securities, LLC met the identified exemption provisions throughout the most recent fiscal year ended December 31, 2020 without exception. 
Brighthouse Securities, LLC's Exemption Report
