12 **NOTICE REGARDING STATUTORY**
13 **DISQUALIFICATION OF ASSOCIATED**
14 **PERSON OF SECURITY-BASED SWAP**
15 **DEALER**

16 Citibank, N.A. (“CBNA”), a national banking association organized and existing under
17 the laws of the United States of America and a provisionally registered swap dealer with the
18 Commodity Futures Trading Commission that applied for registration as a security-based swap
19 dealer (“SBSD”) with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC” or “Commission”),
20 hereby provides notice that Michael C. Furman (CRD No. 4289000), a person who will be
21 associated with CBNA, is currently subject to a statutory disqualification pursuant to Section
22 3(a)(39) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Exchange Act”).

23 Mr. Furman is subject to a statutory disqualification as a result of his September 19, 2013
24 guilty plea, and conviction for, Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child Under 15-
25 Years of Age, a felony in violation of New York law (the “Conviction”). The Conviction will
26 constitute a statutory disqualification until September 19, 2023.

1 All matters giving rise to Mr. Furman's statutory disqualification were subject to a
2 process where his continued association with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority
3 ("FINRA") was approved. On October 21, 2013, Citigroup Global Markets Inc. ("CGMI"), an
4 affiliate of CBNA, filed a Membership Continuance Application ("MC-400") with FINRA
5 seeking to permit Mr. Furman's continued association with CGMI as a general securities
6 representative and equity trader. On April 6, 2016, FINRA filed a Rule 19h-1 of the Exchange
7 Act notice ("19h-1 Notice") with the Commission approving the MC-400 application and
8 permitting Mr. Furman's continued association with CGMI. On August 18, 2016, the
9 Commission acknowledged that association (the "SEC Acknowledgement"). A copy of the 19h-
10 1 Notice and SEC Acknowledgement has been provided to the Commission confidentially at
11 Exhibit A. On May 23, 2019, FINRA approved a change of Mr. Furman's alternate supervisor
12 (the "May 23, 2019 Approval"). A copy of the May 23, 2019 Approval has been provided to the
13 Commission confidentially at Exhibit B.

16 In connection with Mr. Furman's MC-400 application and as reflected in Exhibits A and
17 B, Mr. Furman and CGMI agreed to a plan of supervision in connection with Mr. Furman's
18 continued association with the Firm. Mr. Furman continues to be subject to that plan of
19 supervision and the plan of supervision will apply to Mr. Furman's SBSD activities at CBNA as
20 well as his broker-dealer activities. Additionally, the terms and conditions of Mr. Furman's
21 proposed association with CBNA are the same in all material respects as those reflected in the
22 19h-1 Notice, and any updates related thereto regarding Mr. Furman's supervision.

25 Mr. Furman's primary supervisor for broker-dealer purposes is John Nidds (CRD No.
26 2507737), Managing Director, Head of US Equity Salestrading at CGMI and his alternate
27 supervisor is Timothy Gately (CRD No. 2570328), Managing Director, Americas Head of

1 Equities Sales. Mr. Furman's supervisors will remain the same for his SBSD activities. Mr.
2 Furman currently works from a branch office located at 388 Greenwich Street, New York, New
3 York.
