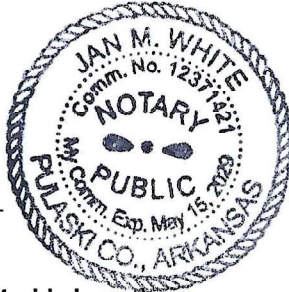

Opinion on The Financial Statements
