



St.George upgrades profit target & rules out potential for buy back in 2003

St.George today announced an upgrade for its 2003 full year Earnings Per Share (EPS) growth target to a range of 13 to 14 per cent. The previous range was 11 to 13 per cent, up from an original 10 per cent. Double-digit EPS growth targets for 2004 and 2005 were also re-affirmed.

St. George also announced that growth in residential receivables for the ten months ended July 2003 was 17.5 per cent annualised.

St.George reported in its March interim results that housing lending had risen 12.5 per cent on an annualised basis. Growth for the full year 2002 was 8.6 per cent.

The solid momentum in residential lending can be attributed to favourable market conditions and a range of initiatives previously announced to the market. These initiatives include improving retention, more effective use of brokers particularly in Queensland and Victoria and boosting productivity in the proprietary lending channel.

Commercial lending has also been strong with annualised growth of 23.8 per cent for the ten months ended July 2003. This compares to 23.5 per cent for the six months ended March 2003. This growth has been primarily achieved from doing more with existing customers and high customer retention levels.

In light of the strong lending growth, the potential for a share buy back in 2003 no longer exists.

Managing Director Gail Kelly commented that 'the upgrade in the current year's EPS target and the continued profitable growth and sound quality in the Bank's lending businesses is pleasing. This healthy momentum in our business has allowed us to further upgrade our EPS targets for the 2003-year, and reaffirm double-digit EPS growth targets for 2004 and 2005'.



St.George announces Crusade Global Trust No. 2 of 2003

St.George Bank today announced the start of a marketing campaign for a proposed global mortgage backed securities issue under the Crusade securitisation programme.

The issue is to be known as Crusade Global Trust No.2 of 2003. The securities will be registered by the Securities and Exchange Commission of the U.S. and will be backed by Australian residential mortgage loans originated by St.George.

Securities with an equivalent value of A\$2.2 billion in total will be issued, with a senior tranche of approximately US\$1.4 billion and subordinated tranches of approximately A\$46 million. It is expected that the senior tranche will be rated AAA by Standard and Poor's and by Fitch and Aaa by Moody's Investors Service.

The issue will be Lead Managed by JP Morgan, with Barclays Capital, Credit Suisse First Boston and Deutsche Bank Securities as Co-Managers.

A registration statement relating to these securities has been filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission but has not yet become effective. These securities may not be sold nor may offers to buy be accepted prior to the time the registration statement becomes effective. This communication shall not constitute an offer to sell or the solicitation of an offer to buy nor shall there be any sale of these securities in any state in which such offer, solicitation or sale would be unlawful prior to registration or qualification under the securities laws of any such state.




