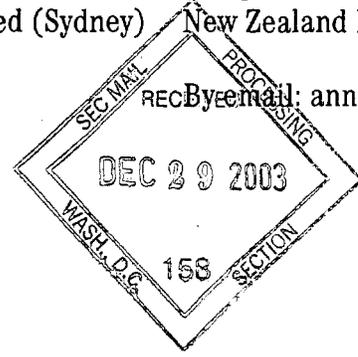

SALE OF LEND LEASE MORTGAGE CAPITAL COMPLETED

Lend Lease Corporation Limited ("LLC") today announced that it has completed its previously announced sale of the assets and specific liabilities of the Lend Lease Mortgage Capital ("LLMC") business to Wachovia Corporation for a price of approximately US\$41.6 million (approximately A\$56 million).

The sale price compares to the book value of the LLMC business of approximately US\$38 million (approximately A\$51 million).

The sale included the transfer of Mortgage Loans work in progress (US\$139 million at 30 June 2003) and an offsetting debt facility (US\$nil at 30 June 2003).

The partnership between Actus Lend Lease and the U.S. Army will oversee all aspects of the 50 year project, including development, design, construction, financing and property and maintenance management of 4,255 homes and multiple community facilities.

The project has a total value of approximately US\$1.6 billion over the 50 years, including an initial development scope of approximately US\$190 million.
