

ING AND MACQUARIE BANK IN DISCUSSIONS OVER SALE OF ING ASIAN EQUITIES BUSINESS

ING Group (ING) and Australia's Macquarie Bank Limited (Macquarie) announced today they had agreed to enter into a period of exclusive due diligence in relation to the proposed purchase by Macquarie of ING's equity sales, trading, research and Equity Capital Markets businesses across Asia. The businesses include operations in 10 Asian countries; Hong Kong, Korea, Japan, Taiwan, Thailand, Singapore, China, Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines. The due diligence also includes ING's Asian sales and trading desks in London and Asian sales desks in New York and other key markets.

Following the proposed sale, ING would continue to offer equity derivatives, mergers and acquisitions advisory, debt capital markets and fixed income products, foreign exchange and treasury, structured finance and syndicated loans to clients in 12 countries in Asia.

Any agreement between ING and Macquarie would be subject to the completion of due diligence, documentation and all relevant internal and regulatory approvals.

The parties expect to make a further announcement before March 31, 2004.
