



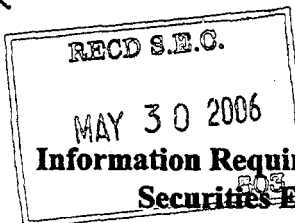

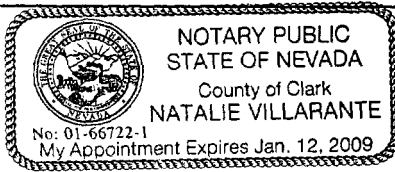

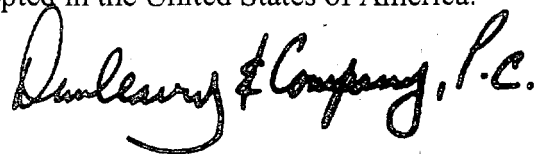
INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

YEAR ENDED MARCH 31, 2006

NOTE 1 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Organization - The Company, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Seibt Enterprises, Inc., was incorporated in the state of Nevada on October 11, 1988. The Company is registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission and is a member of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. The Company's principal business activity is the sale of securities.

Securities Owned - Securities positions are valued at market value and securities not readily marketable are valued at fair value as determined by the board of directors. The resulting difference between cost and market (or fair value) is included in income.

Securities Transactions - Commission revenue and related expense arising from securities transactions are recorded on a trade date basis.

Cash Equivalents - Cash equivalents are defined as certificates of deposit and U.S. government obligations with a maturity date, when purchased by the Company, of less than 90 days and those securities registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 which are comprised of cash and other short-term debt instruments and are commonly referred to as "money market funds."

Concentration of Risk - Substantially all the Company's cash is on deposit at one financial institution and the balance at times may exceed the federally insured limit. Due to the strong credit rating of this financial institution, the Company believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk to cash.

Furniture and equipment - Depreciation is provided using the straight-line method over five and seven year periods.

Estimates - The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

NOTE 2 - NET CAPITAL REQUIREMENTS

As a registered broker/dealer and member of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. the Company is subject to the Uniform Net Capital Rule, which requires the maintenance of minimum net capital and requires that the ratio of aggregated indebtedness to net capital, both as defined, shall not exceed 1500%. At March 31, 2006 the Company's net capital and required net capital were \$22,117 and \$5,000 respectively. The ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital was 37%.

NOTE 3 - LEASE COMMITMENT

Minimum annual rentals under a lease for office space that is classified as an operating lease and expires February 29, 2008, exclusive of additional payments which may be required for certain increases in operating and maintenance costs, are as follows:

The total expenditure for office space for the year ended March 31, 2006 was \$57,891.

NOTE 4 - INCOME TAXES

The Company reports its income for federal income tax purposes on a calendar year basis. As of December 31, 2005 the Company had yet unused a net operating loss a carryforward of \$835,287 which begins to expire on January 1, 2012.

NOTE 5 - RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

As mentioned in Note 1, the Company is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Seibt Enterprises, Inc. In addition, through common ownership the Company is affiliated with Clark and Nye County Development Corp., NS Development and NVS Insurance (NVS).

Pursuant to a written agreement, NVS has paid the Company \$95,000 during the year ended March 31, 2006 for services provided and as reimbursement of various expenses the Company incurred on NVS's behalf. This amount is included as "Management fees" revenue on the Statement of Income.
