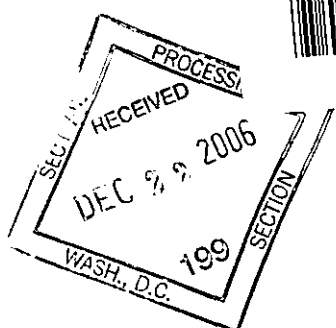



* All ongoing costs and expenses associated with the general administration and operation of the Issue and Concordia Distressed Debt Fund, L.P. (the "Master Fund"), including (without limitation) administration fees and expenses and all accounting (and audit) and legal fees in relation to the affairs of the Issuer and the Master Fund will be borne by the limited partners of the Issuer, directly or indirectly, in accordance with their *pro rata* ownership of the Issuer and the Master Fund. In consideration for their services, Concordia Advisors Bermuda Ltd. and Concordia Advisors, L.L.C., (the "Investment Advisors") will receive between them a monthly asset-based fee (the "Management Fee") from the Issuer at the end of each calendar month in an amount equal to one-sixth (1/6th) of one percent (a two percent (2%) per annum rate) of the sum of all of the Issuer's capital attributable to the Interests, determined after the Issuer's monthly allocations have been made, but prior to allocation of Management or Incentive Fees. An Investment Advisor may, in its sole discretion, waive or rebate all or part of the Management Fee otherwise due with respect to any investment. The Investment Advisors will also receive between them a performance-based fee (the "Incentive Fee") at the end of each calendar quarter with respect to each limited partner equal to twenty percent (20%) of the sum of the Investment Profit (as defined in the Partnership Agreement).
