Dear Shareholder



Please find enclosed your 2009 final dividend statement.

As you would be aware, the past financial year was very challenging. It was a year in which all financial institutions around the world were tested not only by a highly disrupted operating environment, but also by the spread of this disruption to other sectors and the broader economy.

Amidst this market and economic turbulence, Macquarie remained profitable, reporting an after-tax profit of \$A871 million for the 2009 financial year. In addition, we further bolstered our strong funding and capital positions by increasing the level of cash and liquid assets by more than 45 per cent and maintaining a capital buffer of more than 40 per cent in excess of our minimum requirements.

Our profit for the 2009 financial year was 52 per cent lower than the record result recorded in the 2008 financial year and included \$A2.5 billion in write-downs and provisions due to the extremely challenging global operating environment. The majority of these write-downs and provisions are unrealised and stem from strategic investments in Macquarie-managed funds which align our interests with those of other fund investors.

A strong risk management culture, our ability to adapt to change, the diversity of our businesses and our focus on the medium term have been instrumental in ensuring we avoided many of the pitfalls that have affected the financial services industry over the last year.

Importantly, we have consistently grown our capital base ahead of our business requirements and to ensure we have sufficient capacity to maintain operations in challenging market conditions. We raised capital in 2007 and 2008 and we have raised a further \$A1.2 billion since 31 March 2009. This is a prudent measure and provides us with the flexibility to take advantage of current and future opportunities.

We have entered Macquarie's fortieth anniversary year enthusiastic about the new initiatives that we are pursuing across all our businesses. These initiatives include acquisitions, new products and services, and expansion of our existing businesses. Many of these initiatives, such as the recent acquisition of energy


