NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Organization

The Courtney Group, LLC (the "Company") was organized, as a limited liability company and commenced operations in 2002. The limited liability agreement provides for the Company to terminate on May 11, 2091, unless dissolved sooner.

Principal Business Activity

The Company is a registered broker-dealer with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") and the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc. ("FINRA") and is a member of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation ("SIPC"). The Company is engaged in investment banking activities both as an advisor and placement agent in the placement of debt and equity securities to qualified investors and as an advisor to entities engaged in mergers, acquisitions, divestitures and joint ventures.

Financial Statement Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America may require management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Revenue Recognition

The Company receives fees for advising clients in mergers and acquisitions and by acting as a placement agent. Fees for successful placement are recognized when the transaction closes.

Income Taxes

No provision is required for federal or state taxes on the income of the Company. Under the Internal Revenue Code and similar state regulations the Company is treated as a partnership; accordingly, the income to the company is taxed to the member.

Fair Value Measurement

Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) 820, Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures bear no material effect on the financial statements as presented.

NOTE 2. NET CAPITAL REQUIREMENTS

The company is subject to the Securities and Exchange Commission Uniform Net Capital Rule (SEC rule 15c3-1), which requires the maintenance of minimum net capital and requires that the ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital, both as defined, shall not exceed 15 to 1. At December 31, 2010 the Company had net capital of 11,518, which was 6,518 in excess of its required net capital of 5,000. The Company's ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital was .51 to 1.

NOTE 3. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Company shared office space with a company related through common ownership that, for 2010, has elected to waive the rent and certain other overhead expenses that would otherwise be charged to the Company for use of office space. The affiliate has adequate resources independent of the Company to pay these expenses, and the Company has no additional obligation, either direct or indirect, to compensate a third party for these expenses.

Subsequent events have been evaluated and no events have been identified which require disclosure.
