




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

Note 1- Nature of Business

Acer Investment Group, LLC, a limited liability company (The "Company") is a broker/dealer in securities, registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission and is a member of the Chicago Stock Exchange.

The "Company" operates under the provisions of Paragraph (k)(2)(ii) of Rule 15c3-3 of the Securities Exchange Commission, and accordingly is exempt from the remaining provisions of that rule.

Note 2- Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

- a) **Revenue Recognition**
Securities transactions (and the recognition of related income and expenses) are recorded on a trade date basis.
- b) **Marketable Securities**
Marketable securities owned by the Company are reflected at market value with the resulting unrealized gains and losses included in income.
- c) **Cash and Cash Equivalents**
The Company considers money market funds to be cash. The Company maintains cash in bank accounts which, at times, may exceed federally insured limits. The Company has not experienced any losses in such accounts and does not believe it is exposed to any significant credit risk on cash and cash equivalents.
- d) **Income Taxes**
Income taxes are not payable by, nor provided for, the Company. Members are taxed individually on their share of company earnings for federal and state income tax purposes.
- e) **Depreciation**
Depreciation of furniture and equipment is computed on the straight-line method using estimated useful lives of five to seven years.
- f) **Use of Estimates**
Management uses estimates and assumptions in preparing financial statements. Those estimates and assumptions may affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses.
- g) **Subsequent Events**
The company has evaluated events and transactions that occurred between December 31, 2013 and February 5, 2014, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued, for possible disclosure and recognition in the financial statements.

Note 3- Major Service Providers

The Company currently has one service provider relationship. The one relationship accounted for 73% of total dividend finder's fees.

Note 5 - Profit Sharing Plan

The Company is a sponsor of a defined contribution profit sharing plan for its eligible employees. Contributions to the plan, if any, are determined by the employer and come out of its current accumulated profits. The employer's contribution for any fiscal year shall not exceed the maximum allowable as a deduction to the employer under the provisions of the IRS Code Section 404, as amended, or replaced from time to time. The Company contributed \$25,250 for the year ended December 31, 2013. The Company's liability to the plan for the year ended December 31, 2013, was \$-0-.

Note 6 - Commitments and Contingencies

Office Lease

The Company leases two premises under leases expiring October 31, 2014 and August 31, 2015. At December 31, 2013, the minimum rental commitment before escalations under the leases is as follows:

Note 8- Net Capital Requirement

The Company is subject to the Securities and Exchange Commission's Net Capital Rule 15c3-1, which requires the maintenance of minimum net capital and requires that the ratio of aggregate indebtedness to net capital, both as defined, shall not exceed 1500%. At December 31, 2013, the Company's net capital of \$576,819 was \$476,819 in excess of its required net capital of \$100,000. The Company's net capital ratio was 16.77%.
