



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

NOTE 1 – SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

NATURE OF OPERATIONS

Faver Securities, LLC is a registered broker-dealer with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority Inc. (FINRA).

Faver Securities, LLC's current line of business is mutual fund retail on a subscription basis but has also been approved for variable life and annuities. Faver does not hold customer funds or securities. Commissions are paid periodically by the mutual fund companies with which Faver has direct selling agreements.

USE OF ESTIMATES

The preparation of the Company's financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the financial statements and related disclosures. Management believes that the estimates utilized in the preparation of these financial statements are prudent and reasonable. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

The Company considers all highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

INCOME TAXES

As a single-member LLC, no provision for federal or state income taxes is required as its member is responsible for reporting the Company's income or loss under applicable income tax statutes and regulations.

NOTE 2 - COMMITMENTS AND CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

As of December 31, 2014 the Company had no financial instruments with off balance sheet risk of a material nature.

The Company advises that there is no litigation of a material nature pending against the Company.

NOTE 3- RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

There has been no related party transactions during the year ended December 31, 2014.

NOTE 4- SIPC RECONCILIATION REQUIREMENT

SEA Rule 17a-5(e)(4) requires a registered broker-dealer to file a supplemental report which includes procedures related to broker-dealers SIPC annual general assessment reconciliation or exclusion from membership forms. In circumstances where the broker-dealer reports \$500,000 or less in gross revenue they are not required to file supplemental SIPC report. The Company is exempt from filing the supplemental report under SEA Rule 17a-5(e)(4) because it is reporting less than \$500,000 in gross revenue.

NOTE 5- SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

The Company has evaluated subsequent events from January 1, 2015 through February 12, 2015, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued, and has concluded that there are no reportable subsequent events of a material nature.
