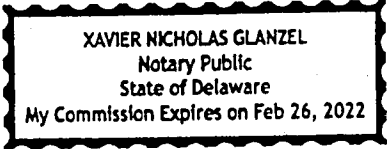

(1) SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

NATURE OF ORGANIZATION

Lee Financial Securities, Inc. (the “*Company*”), a Hawaii Corporation, was formed on May 13, 1988, and is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Lee Financial Group Hawaii, Inc., an investment management services organization. The Company is registered as a general securities broker-dealer with the Securities and Exchange Commission.

The Company has a distribution agreement with Lee Financial Mutual Fund, Inc. (the “*Fund*”), a non-diversified, open-end, management investment company. Pursuant to Rule 12b-1 of the Investment Company Act of 1940, a distribution plan adopted by the Fund reimburses the Company for certain expenses incurred in distributing the Fund’s shares.

INCOME TAXES

The Company is included in the consolidated federal and state income tax returns of its parent. Income taxes are provided for on a separate return basis only to the extent that income tax expense (credit) is incurred by the consolidated group. Although income tax expense was incurred by the consolidated group for the year ended December 31, 2020, no provision was allocated, due to the net loss incurred by the Company for the year.

Management has analyzed the Company’s tax positions and has concluded that no liability for unrecognized tax benefits should be recorded related to uncertain tax positions taken on federal, state and local income tax returns for open years (2017 – 2019) or expected to be taken on the Company’s 2020 tax return.

USE OF ESTIMATES

In preparing financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, management makes estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements, as well as the reported amounts of income and expenses during the reported period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

FAIR VALUE OF FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

The carrying amounts of cash, receivables, and accrued expenses approximate fair value because of the short maturity of these items.

REVENUE RECOGNITION

Customers’ securities transactions are reported on a settlement date basis with related income and expenses reported on a trade date basis. On January 1, 2018, the Company adopted ASU 2014-09 Revenue from Contracts with Customers and all subsequent amendments to the ASU (collectively, “ASC 606”), which (i) creates a single framework for recognizing revenue from contracts with customers that fall within its scope and (ii) revises when it is appropriate to recognize a gain (loss) from the transfer of nonfinancial assets. The Company has evaluated the ASC 606 guidance and determined that the adoption did not have a material impact on the Company’s financial statements.

SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

Subsequent events after the balance sheet date through the date that the financial statements were issued have been evaluated in the preparation of the financial statements. Based on that evaluation, Management has determined that no subsequent events have occurred which would require disclosure in the financial statements.

(2) REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

The Company is exempt from the provisions of Rule 15c3-3 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (reserve requirement for brokers and dealers) in that the Company does not hold funds or securities for customers and it promptly transmits all funds and delivers all securities in connection with its activities as a broker or dealer.

Pursuant to the net capital provisions of Rule 15c3-1 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Company is required to maintain a minimum net capital, as defined, equal to the greater of \$5,000 or 6-2/3% of aggregate indebtedness. Net capital and the related net capital ratio may fluctuate on a daily basis. At December 31, 2020 the Company had net capital of \$18,998, and net capital requirements of \$5,000. The percentage of aggregate indebtedness to net capital was 118.44%.

(3) RELATED PARTIES

One of the Company's directors serves on the Board of Directors of Lee Financial Mutual Fund, Inc. from which the Company receives its revenue.

(4) REVENUE FROM CONTRACTS WITH CUSTOMERS

The Company enters into arrangements with the Fund to distribute shares to investors. The Company receives distribution fees paid by the Fund. The Company believes that its performance obligation is the sale of securities to investors and as such this is fulfilled on the trade date. Distribution fees recognized in the current period are primarily related to performance obligations that have been satisfied in prior periods. For the fiscal year ended 2020, the Company received distribution fee revenue of \$241,218 which represents all the revenue for this fiscal year.
