OR

You must have a rating by the Department of Veterans Affairs showing a compensable service-connected disability of 30 percent or more. All other veterans are ineligible to attend this event.

AND

You must pre-register by providing your full name and resume by July 13 to DisabilityEmploymentProgram@sec.gov. Due to limited space, the capacity is 75 guests.
