POSTPONEMENT ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on January 6, 2014. A hearing is currently scheduled for January 27, 2014.

The Office of the Secretary and the Division of Enforcement have provided evidence that, in accordance with Rule 141(a)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, China Metallic Resources, Inc., China Timber Work Enterprises, Inc., and Premier International Hotel Group, Inc. (collectively, Served Respondents), were served with the OIP by U.S. Postal Service Express Mail by January 13, 2014. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Served Respondents' Answers to the OIP are due within ten days of service of the OIP, or by January 27, 2014. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). No evidence of service on Linda Illumination, Inc. (Linda Illumination), has been received yet.

To allow time for service on Linda Illumination and Served Respondents' Answers, it is ORDERED that the hearing is POSTPONED sine die and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on February 18, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. EST, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
