ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND
SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On April 22, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding against Brian Williamson, Esq., with an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings and Imposing Temporary Suspension, pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(B) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Mr. Williamson filed a petition with the Commission to lift the temporary suspension, and on June 19, 2014, the Commission denied his petition and set the matter down for a hearing. See Williamson, Securities Exchange Act of 1934 Release No. 72435, 2014 SEC LEXIS 2144 (June 19, 2014). The hearing is scheduled to commence on July 11, 2014.

It is ORDERED that the hearing scheduled to begin on July 11, 2014, is POSTPONED sine die and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on July 17, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. EDT.
