The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), on September 29, 2014. The OIP alleges that Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports.

The parties have submitted a Joint Motion to Stay pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), stating that they have agreed in principle to a settlement that would resolve the proceeding. Accordingly, the proceeding will be stayed, contingent upon compliance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2).
