ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On March 10, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

On March 24, 2015, I issued an order, instructing the parties to meet and confer and file a joint prehearing conference statement by certain dates, and finding that Respondent's Answer is due by April 8, 2015. *Robert J. Lunn*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2459, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1058. On March 25, 2015, Respondent filed a motion seeking an extension of time of fourteen days to file his Answer. Respondent contends that his counsel requires the extension to become familiar with Commission procedures and the securities law applicable to this proceeding.

For good cause shown and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, Respondent's motion is GRANTED. Respondent shall have until April 22, 2015, to file an Answer. All other deadlines set by my order of March 24, 2015, remain unchanged.
