MOAZZAM "MARK" MALIK : POSTPONEMENT ORDER

---

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on January 27, 2016, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on February 22, 2016. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on Respondent Moazzam "Mark" Malik's 2015 conviction of several felonies under New York state law, including grand larceny, forgery, and securities fraud. Malik is currently incarcerated.

The Division of Enforcement has requested that the hearing be postponed in order for it to: (1) ascertain whether Malik has been properly served with the OIP; (2) to contact Malik to find out whether he plans to submit an answer to the OIP; and (3) try to schedule a time for a telephonic prehearing conference. Consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed *sine die*. The Division will report on its efforts by March 11, 2016.
