ORDER POSTPONING HEARING
AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On February 1, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

On February 12, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by February 9, 2016, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). Accordingly, Respondents' answers to the OIP are due by February 22, 2016. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for February 23, 2016, is POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 2:00 p.m. EST on March 7, 2016. If Respondents fail to timely file answers, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
