ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 12, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings.

On September 8, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed an updated declaration of service establishing that Respondent was served with the OIP by mail, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), on September 6, 2016. Respondent's answer was therefore due by September 19, 2016. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, Respondent has not filed an answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER Respondent to SHOW CAUSE by October 3, 2016, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this order, it will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
