ORDER DESIGNATING
PRESIDING JUDGE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on September 29, 2016. The OIP ordered that a public hearing shall be convened “following the entry of a final judgment against the last remaining defendant(s) in all actions related to the conduct described” in the OIP to determine “what, if any, civil penalties pursuant to Section 21(B)(a) of the Exchange Act against Respondent Frank are in the public interest.” OIP at 34, 44-45.

I ORDER that Administrative Law Judge Jason S. Patil shall preside at the hearing in these proceedings and perform other and related duties in accordance with the Commission’s Rules of Practice. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.110.
