ORDER DIRECTING DIVISION OF
ENFORCEMENT TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL
DECLARATION OF SERVICE AND
RESCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On March 10, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against each Respondent. The two proceedings were consolidated pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.201(a). *Talman Harris*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4675, 2017 SEC LEXIS 753, at *1 (ALJ Mar. 13, 2017). On April 10, 2017, I ordered the Division of Enforcement to file a declaration of service and scheduled a telephonic prehearing conference for May 2, 2017. *Talman Harris*, Admin Proc. Rulings Release No. 4741, 2017 SEC LEXIS 1091, at *1.

On April 21, 2017, the Division submitted a declaration as ordered. Although the declaration documents impressive efforts to serve Respondents, it also shows that the Division sent Respondents the OIPs by UPS overnight delivery instead of “U.S. Postal Service certified, registered or Express Mail,” which does not comply with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i).

To allow time for service to be reattempted, I ORDER the Division to file, by May 1, 2017, a supplemental declaration regarding the status of lawful service of the appropriate OIP on each Respondent.

And I FURTHER ORDER that the telephonic prehearing conference is RESCHEDULED to May 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. Eastern.
