ORDER SETTING
BRIEFING SCHEDULE

After the Securities and Exchange Commission initiated this proceeding, Respondent Victory Park Acquisition Corp. I filed an answer in which it admitted the operative allegations in the order instituting proceedings (OIP). It admitted that it: (1) is registered with the Commission under Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act; (2) has not submitted any required periodic filings since it filed Forms 10-K and 10-K/A in February 2011 for the period ended November 30, 2010; and (3) has “failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and/or 13a-13 thereunder.” Answer at 1–5. The Division of Enforcement responded to Victory Park’s answer by filing a motion for ruling on the pleadings. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(a).

In light of the foregoing, Victory Park shall respond to the Division’s motion by May 30, 2017. Victory Park should address the Division’s arguments and should additionally address why I should not resolve this matter based on the parties’ written submissions. *See Citizens Capital Corp.*, Securities Exchange Act of 1934 Release No. 67313, 2012 WL 2499350, at *8 (June 29, 2012) (“summary disposition is appropriate in proceedings ... brought pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(j), where the issuer has not disputed the facts that constitute the violation.”). The Division may file a reply by June 5, 2017.
