ORDER POSTPONING HEARING
AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On May 24, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled to commence on June 14, 2017.

As of today, this office has received no evidence that service of the OIP has been effected on Respondents pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a). Accordingly, I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on August 17, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern, if service has been effected by then. I FURTHER ORDER that the Division of Enforcement shall file a declaration regarding the status of service efforts by June 16, 2017.
