Order Postponing Hearing

On June 20, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

On June 28, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration of service establishing that Respondent dELiA*s Inc., was served with the OIP in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), via U.S. Postal Service Priority Mail Express on June 22, 2017. As such, its answer is due by July 5, 2017. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

The Division shall file another declaration of service when Respondent Global Energy, Inc., is served, and I will schedule a prehearing conference at that time. In the meantime, I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for July 14, 2017.
