**Order to Show Cause**

On July 27, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings. Respondent was served with the OIP on July 31, 2017, and its answer was due by August 14, 2017. *CNK Glob., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4955, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2396 (ALJ Aug. 7, 2017). Respondent did not file an answer or appear at the prehearing conference held on August 29, 2017.

I ORDER Respondent to SHOW CAUSE by September 8, 2017, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
