Stay Order

On October 31, 2017, the Division of Enforcement and Respondent Gold Hill Resources, Inc., submitted a joint motion to stay this proceeding based on their agreement in principle to a settlement on all major terms.¹

To allow the Securities and Exchange Commission time to consider the settlement offer, the motion is GRANTED, and the proceeding is STAYED as to Gold Hill Resources, subject to compliance with Rule of Practice 161(c)(2), 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), requiring the parties to promptly notify this office if any of the requirements of the rule are not met.
